# MIT-NORWAY: UNIVERSITY OF BERGEN SEED FUND

## About the Fund

The MIT-Norway: University of Bergen Seed Fund is a part of the **MIT Global Seed Funds**. The fund supports collaborations between faculty and researchers at MIT and their counterparts in the Faculties of Humanities and Medicine at the University of Bergen (UiB). Proposals must be linked to an identified research group or researcher permanently employed at UiB and can include all disciplines represented at the Faculties. Collaborations involving researchers in early or mid-career stages are encouraged.



The maximum award is \$30,000. The application deadline is December 16, 2025

## Priority will be given to projects that:

- Are new or are entering a new phase
- Involve students (including PhD candidates) in a meaningful way
- Have high potential for impact beyond the initial funding period, such as continued collaboration, joint proposals, or other opportunities
- Include a balanced exchange and demonstrate complementarity between the two universities
- The UiB Faculty of Humanities particularly encourages proposals that involve interdisciplinary collaboration and/or digital humanities.
